- D Swamp Rabbit Trail – outdoor cleanup/mulching. 9:00 – 11:30am Up to 50 people. All ages.
- E Meyer Center: Power wash and clean furniture. 9:00 – 11:30am Up to 10 people. Ages 12 and up.
- F Pendleton Place: Host party for 10 high school girls. 10am - Noon. Up to 4 people. Adult.
- G SOS Thrift Store: Sort, clean donated items. 9:30 -11:30am. Up to 4 people. Ages 12 and up.
- H Triune Mercy Center: Building shelves and hanging racks in closet. 4 hours. Up to 4 people. Adult.

- J Help with meal preparation at the church for breakfast and lunch. Up to 6 people. Adult.
